





II. ATTORNEY'S FEES

If no acceptable copy or ad material has been received by deadline, the publisher reserves the right to charge the advertiser and/or agency for the space reserved.

If the Advertiser is unable to complete his/her contract, the Advertiser will be billed for the number of paid insertions completed, at the rate of the nearest completed frequency.

IV. TERMINATION

Company (Katy Christian Magazine and/or Fort Bend Christian Magazine) reserves the right to terminate this Agreement for any reason whatsoever by Company providing a ten (10) day notice to Advertiser. In the event of termination, the sole liability of Company shall be to refund to Advertiser any (unearned) advance payment from the effective date of such termination. Advertiser may terminate this Agreement by paying Company all amounts due through the effective due date of termination, together with an amount of seventy-five percent (75%) of the remaining balance of the term of this Agreement which Advertiser would have been obligated to pay from the effective date of termination until the end of the existing Agreement term. In the event of a default by Advertiser, in as much as the breach of this Agreement by Advertiser will cause a serious and substantial damage to Company, and because it will be difficult if not impossible to prove the amount of such damage, Advertiser agrees that in the case of termination following any breach by Advertiser (including breach by Advertiser's failure to make payments). V. RENEWALTERMS

Following the initial term, this agreement will automatically renew on a month-to-month basis, until terminated.

VI. TEXAS LAW TO APPLY

This Agreement shall be construed under and in accordance with the laws of Texas, and all obligations of the parties created hereunder are performable in Harris County, TX.

VII. PARTIES BOUND

This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns where permitted by this Agreement.

VIII. LEGAL CONSTRUCTION

In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions thereof and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

IV. PRIOR AGREEMENTS SUPERSEDED
